關於安徒生會 Introduction of HAC

「安徒生會」是一間本地慈善團體,服務香港基層兒 童及其家庭,相信故事可以感染孩子,裝備孩子擁有 良好品格,從書本中學習,啟發思考及創造力。

HAC is a local non-profit organization that serves underprivileged children and families. We believe stories can cultivate children with good qualities, inspire their thinking and encourage active learning.

安徒生會成立於1963年,一直以「關懷子女、培育社群」為宗旨,提倡活用繪本故事,推廣閱讀文化,是本港創意故事演繹及遊戲之先行者。

本會致力以三大服務方針:創新活用故事、培育正向心靈及多元金齡共融,支援及為基層兒童和家庭開展全人發展服務,積極透過提供故事資源及專業培訓、親子溝通活動等,協助兒童與知識型社會接動。

安徒生會以丹麥著名童話故事家命 名,希望突顯該會的服務不分種族、 國界和宗教。 Established in 1963, Hans Andersen Club aims to serve the community with mission - Cherish our Children, Cultivate our Community. HAC has pioneered the culture of creative storytelling and interactive games in Hong Kong.

HAC serves underprivileged children and their families by three major perspectives: providing creative storytelling activities, developing positive mindset and embracing social inclusion. HAC supports children a holistic development and cultivates parent-child relationships in order to adapt to the knowledge-based society.

Named after one of the greatest fairy tales' authors, HAC's service is regardless of nationality and religion.

培育正向心靈

透過廣泛地接觸小學、幼稚園和社福機構,我們積極地向學生和家長提供一系列自創的教育工作坊、兒童動畫影片、理財資源冊,以及由兒童營運大型市集,宣揚健康正確的金錢觀,減少浪費,學懂分享。普遍來說,香港的親子教育一向甚少涉及理財,透過以上多元化渠道和有趣生動的資源,適時補充這個缺口;相信孩子建立了正確的理財觀念,能終生受用!

另外值得欣喜的是,已經推行多年的 「悅讀新視野」計劃,榮獲香港城市 大學人文社會科學院頒發「知識轉移 卓越大獎」,並多次在國際會議上發 表計劃成果。





多元金齡共融

隨著人口老化, 安徒生會積極組織不同年紀的 人士參與社區公益事務, 從中讓參加者互相欣 賞, 分享彼此的強項,達至長幼共融。當中成 效顯著的例子有:

- 耆妙童話義人行
- 「賽馬會南丫好拍檔」計劃
- 「從SUN出發。融義旅情」計劃



我們和眾多的持份者建立堅實的聯繫和信任, 讓我們可以團結一致面對挑戰。 就好像在第五波疫情爆時, 我們迅速地為偏遠離島的居民籌集緊急醫療物資和支援, 就算在我今天行文執筆之際, 仍可以在南丫島山旮旯的村落裏, 發現有居民義工自發整理本會「抗疫速遞到南丫」的資訊海報,深刻感受到他們對我們工作的認同!

本會嚴謹執行社會福利署訂定的「最佳執行指引」第一組的各項標準,當中包括:董事會定期檢視整筆過撥款的儲備使用和合理水平;至2022年3月31日,社會福利署整筆撥款資助服務單位的儲備共\$1,400,408,當中非定影員工的公積金儲備\$247,083。預計於2022-2023財政年度結束後,公積金儲備將減少至\$210,000。公積金儲備按指定之用途,用於非定影員工的公積金供款,為更善用有關儲備,2022-2023財政年度將善用這些金額改善員工福利。

總括而言,縱然過去的日子荊棘滿途,安徒生會仍然沈著應對,穩步向著以上三個服務方向進發,並獲得各大媒體報導共67次篇。感謝社會福利署、社區投資共享基金、香港公益金和香港賽馬會資助本會開展各項服務的營運開支。另外,我們感恩有不同的合作夥伴一同守護香港,守護下一代。

Dear all HAC supporters,

As the old saying goes, "life itself is the most wonderful tale", what is the extraordinary story of HAC in such a challenging year?

Last year, Hong Kong has gone through a series of unprecedent crisis when we're attacked by several rebounds of COVID-19. The situation worsened at the beginning of 2022 when the infected cases soared and many people were unable to receive prompt medical treatment. Physical classes in schools were suspended for months and the local economy was severely shackled. Just like fallen into a dark abyss, many grassroot families had been severely hampered by under-employment or unemployment, and their children education were impeded. Their struggle in the abyss was a deep despair!

HAC was very fortunate to receive various supports, which enabled us to fortify our service users to fight against the crisis:

Storytelling for Social Impact

Stories are good nutrients for our hearts by pacifying anxiety and boosting positivity.



We delivered quality storytelling programs by collaborating with the following partners:

- the Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education (IVE) to host the Easy Learning Internship Program
- Corporate volunteers from the Hang Lung Properties Limited to provide Learn Language From Storybooks Volunteers Program
- Hong Kong Poverty Alleviation Association Ltd. and Hong Kong Poverty Alleviation Foundation to run the Volunteacher- Primary Students Volunteer Support Scheme
- Hong Kong Council of Social Service to organise the Project Futuremark

With their helping hands and generous donation, we supported the children especially those affected by school suspensions or from inadequate houses to seize their golden times for learning. The benefits are not only academic, they learnt how to develop healthy habits, manage their timetable and set their long-term goals. All of these are indeed precious experiences for their life development!

Cultivate Positive Mindset

Positivity through building up proper mindset and partaking into meaningful engagements can fortify our immunity against adversity. With this in mind, HAC had implemented:

- Kidder Banker
- Financial Smarty

With a wide coverage in schools, kindergartens and NGOs, we promoted the financial literacy to young parents by providing them with bespoke education kits, children animation videos, training workshops and even large-scale



flea markets managed by kids. The participants can learn the core concepts of Spending, Saving and Sharing from the Projects. Such knowledge is practical and useful for their lifetime.

We are very thrilled to share our joy with you that the long-term "Read to Change" Project had won the Excellence in Knowledge Transfer Award presented by the City University of Hong Kong. And the project achievements keep presenting in various international conferences.



Embrace Social Inclusion

Seeing that the population is aging, HAC actively engages stakeholders from different age groups for various community services. Intergenerational inclusion can be achieved when they learn from each other and show respect and are appreciated among themselves. Our cases include:

- Intergenerational Story Adventure
- Jockey Club Lamma Buddy Project
- A Blessing Journey in Lamma

With the strong bonding we have built up with a wide range of stakeholders, we are united to strive against different challenges. During the 5th wave of COVID-19, we were in full speed to collect necessary medical reliefs for the patients in remote villages. During my recent faraway hike in Lamma, I discovered that an anonymous volunteer had helped tidied up our publicity poster for "Express Anti-pandemic materials to Lamma". This shows how deep they recognise our work.





We stringently implemented captioned (Level One) to have regular reviews of the usage and reasonable level of Lump Sum Grant Reserve at the board meetings. As of 31st March 2022, the Provident Fund Reserve for nonsnapshot staff of the Social Welfare Department's Lump Sum Grant subvented services unit was \$247,083. It was included in the Lump Sum Grant Reserve which had a balance of \$1,400,408. It is projected that the Provident Fund Reserve will be \$210,000 at the end of the 2022-2023 financial year. The Reserve is to be used for provident fund contribution for nonsnapshot staff. To better utilise the Reserve, HAC planned to enhance the employment terms of staff and so on.

In 2021-2022, we steadfastly moved forward the above three service directions no matter how bumpy our journey was. Our services had 67 media coverage. May I take this opportunity to express our greatest gratitude to the Social Welfare Department, the Community Investment and Inclusion Fund, the Community Chest and Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust. We are also very grateful for all the support received from various partners. Together, we can safeguard Hong Kong and our next generation.

The coming year marks the 60th anniversary of HAC. Along with a series of celebration events, HAC will always keep our beliefs, promote professional storytelling and reading services and enhance the After-School Support for children with Special Learning Needs. I cordially invite your standing by HAC during our adventure towards a better future. After the hard days that making us stronger, ours will be a beautiful story!

Since the opening of Storyland in 2006, HAC has been committed to providing creative, professional and diversified storytelling services to the community. We believe that reading is the perfect way to broaden children's horizons and nourish their minds. Storytelling also plays a significant role in promoting one's imagination, self-confidence and parent-child relationships.

Service User: Children, families and elders in Kowloon

For the past year, Storyland had organized 101 sessions of storytelling workshops (3,204 beneficiaries), 67 sessions of parents workshops (1,166 beneficiaries), 2 sessions of volunteer training (26 beneficiaries), and 15 sessions of professional training (300 beneficiaries).



故事盒 Story Hub

故事盒為港島區家長及幼兒提供創意故事活動,過去2021-2022年度舉辦了8場主題親子故事活動 (超神奇種子鋪、愛與被愛、神奇的藍色水桶、鱷魚艾倫又大又可怕的牙齒、超神奇雨傘鋪、好忙好忙的聖誕節)及5場小草地故事劇場,以提升親子關係,加強幼兒的社交及溝通能力,讓家長及孩子都能在故事盒共享閱讀樂趣。

Story Hub located in Quarry Bay started our service in 2014. Story Hub provides storytelling programme like reading club, parents' sharing and workshops for working parents, aiming to discover parents' storytelling potential, to foster their parent-child relationship and to build up mutual trust in the community.

Story Hub provides creative storytelling activity for parent-child in Hong Kong Island district. We have organized 8 sessions of themed storytelling workshops and 5 sessions of "Grassland Story time" in 2021-2022. We hope that the Parent-child storytelling programme can promote family relationship, children social and communication skills. Both parents and children would enjoy the fun of reading in Story Hub.

集合義工力量,跨越疫境 疫情期間特別支援服務



2022年初本港面對第五波疫情的影響,政府宣布提早於3月份放暑假。為了讓孩子更好地利用這段時間在家學習,過一個有意義的假期。本會包威信中心及竹園中心於3月至4月期間推行了「小學生繪本學語文」(線上版)。計劃結合義工力量,接近30位來自不同界別的義工參與,當中有故事媽媽有不同界別的義工參與,當中有故事媽媽有話動,以一對一至一對二的比例為超過40名兒童提供義教,合共提供500小時故事教學予小學生,從而提升中英文的語文能力。參加的小朋友,家長和義工都能深刻體會在逆境中彼此無私的付出。

The power of volunteerism overcame challenges Special services during COVID-19

Being affected by the fifth wave of in early epidemic 2022, embraced their early summer holiday in March. To let children better utilize the holiday, our Diana Boyd Wilson's Centre and Chuk Yuen Centre introduced the "Learn language from stories" program (online) between March and April. This program combined the power of nearly 30 volunteers from different sectors including storytelling parents, teenagers, retired teachers, etc. The volunteers provided 500 hours of one-to-one or one-to-two voluntary teaching services more than 40 primary school students, aiming to enhance their Chinese and English language ability. Participants, parents and volunteers were all impressed by everyone's selfless giving during the hard times.



During the pandemic, most of the seniors and families with confirmed case were afraid to go out. They relied on family or social service to deliver daily essentials. HAC motivated around 50 volunteers to care them by phone, also package and send antipandemic materials to seniors from 19 dispersed villages. Volunteers showed support to locals to make life easier during the hard times.

We connected with 14 organizations including churches, schools, social service units, volunteer teams and corporates like the Simon K Y Lee Foundation, complemented other, then served the Lamma community. We visited seniors from villages, understood their condition and gave them food packs. Virtual medical consultation, meditation healing art workshops, etc. were also provided for free. 600 seniors were benefited from the project. We hope that the network we built can serve the community better.

香港的幼兒及中小學教育普遍欠缺 教授個人理財的概念的教導,故家 庭便成為兒童個人理財教育的重要 一環。家長在教育幼童如何正確地 看待金錢有著非常重要的角色。承 蒙香港交易所慈善基金支持及香港 公益金撥款,安徒生會開展「童話 理財寶庫」計劃,為幼稚園及小學 提供免費工作坊及講座。

計劃旨在透過繪本故事及體驗活動,讓兒童輕鬆學習正確理財知識,培養善用金錢、自律及愛分享的良好習慣。除兒童活動外,計劃更包含家長教育講座及親子體驗日,配合網上影片及資源套,讓家長認識相關繪本及親職技巧,從日常生活中協助小朋友建立理財概念,學習一點一滴累積財富。本年度服務3,598人次,其中包括20間幼稚園及4間小學。

Education on personal finance is generally lacking in Hong Kong's pre-schools and primary/secondary schools. As a result, families play a significant role in children's wealth management and educating how their children view money correctly. With support from the HKEX Charity Partnership Programme and the Community Chest of Hong Kong, HAC launched the "Financial Smarty" to provide free talks and workshops to kindergartens and primary schools.

This project aims to develop children with good habits of money management, self-discipline and sharing through storybooks and experiential activities. Apart from children's activities, parents' workshops educational and parent-child experiential days were also included. Online videos resources introduced finance-related and storybooks and parenting skills to parents, therefore equipping parents to teach their kids financial concepts in daily life. Beneficiaries this year reached 3,598 from 20 kindergartens and 4 primary schools.

承蒙香港公益金資助,安徒生會開展「耆妙童話義人行」。計劃旨在以創新及多元化的手法,為50歲以上金齡人士提供免費講故事培訓並進行社區實習,為兒童舉辦故事活動。此計劃一方面促進金齡人士建立朋輩網絡及與社區連繫,同時加強跨代溝通,並藉協助社區中心推行閱讀活動,惠及有需要的兒童。我們於7月舉辦「童書為媒連繫長幼」實體及網上分享會,並邀得社會福利署黃大仙及西貢區福利專員呂少英小姐到場加許義工;藝人潘芳芳小姐更即場示範互動故事技巧。逾百社會服務同工出席分享會,進一步推廣跨代共融。本年度服務3,895人次,當中包括22間幼稚園/兒童服務機構及5間長者活動中心。

The project "Intergenerational Story Adventure" was supported by the Community Chest of Hong Kong. This project trained volunteers aged 50 or above for free to become storytellers through creative activities, in return organizing story activities for children. On one hand, the project helped seniors to develop peer networks and connections with the community, thus strengthening cross-generational communication. On the other hand, it promoted reading and gave a hand to needy children. A sharing in both physical and virtual forms was held in July. We were honored to have the chairperson of the District Social Welfare Officer (Wong Tai Sin/Sai Kung) Social Welfare Department, Ms LUI Siu-ying, Micy to be our guest presenting awards to our volunteers. A famous artist Ms Lily Poon Fong Fong demonstrated her interactive storytelling skills to more than a hundred social service workers and other participants. Beneficiaries were 3,895 this year from 22 kindergartens/ children service centres and 5 elderly centres.

本會自2015年起,與香港城市大學社會及 行為科學系副教授馮麗姝博士合辦「悅讀 新視野」計劃,以全球首創的「故事介入 治療法」,提升學童的情緒智商及社交能 力,減低他們的攻擊傾向。「故事介入治 療法」以「社會訊息處理理論」為基礎, 以生活化的繪本故事作媒介,透過繪本共 讀、角色扮演、情景討論,讓學童在故事 社交小組中學習處理情緒、換位思考、應 對衝突。

小組由安徒生會社工帶領,由香港城市大學研究計劃成效。研究結果顯示,「故事介入治療法」有助兒童控制憤怒情緒,亦能減低兒童的攻擊行為指數。七年來,已有超過40間小學參與「悅讀新視野」計劃,計劃在今年獲香港城市大學人文社會科學院頒發「知識轉移卓越大獎」,計劃成果亦在網絡共享研究所舉辦的2022年國際會議上發表。

Starting from 2015, Hans Andersen Club has collaborated with Dr. Annis Fung, the Associate Professor Department of Social and Behavioural Sciences in City University of Hong Kong launching the "Read to Change" project. The project, based on the theory of social information process (SIP), aims to provide school-based using storytelling groups intervention platform including reading storybooks, role-playing and scenario discussion promote children's pro-social behaviours, and conflict childhood aggression management.

Those groups were led by social workers from HAC, and results were analyzed by the City University of Hong Kong. The research revealed that the intervention is effective in preventing children from becoming revengers and reducing children's aggressive behaviour. In the previous 7 years, more than 40 primary schools have participated in the project. The project received an Excellence in Knowledge Transfer Awards presented by the City University of Hong Kong and the project result was presented at the virtual global conference in 2022.

在香港公益金的支持下,計劃進一步擴大服務範圍,除了在中心及小學提供故事社交小組,亦在小學舉辦學生故事講座及家長教育工作坊。在2021至2022年,已有11間小學參與計劃,受惠人次達8,979人。學生故事講座透過繪本閱讀、情境討論及真實故事,讓學生學習尊重差異及應對欺凌;家長教育工作坊透過繪本分享及體驗活動,啟發家長對教養方式的思考,協助家長以同理心支持孩子成長。為鼓勵家長善用繪本與孩子交流,更推出親子共讀手冊,為家長提供繪本的閱讀方向及活動建議,讓家長和孩子一同在繪本中的成長。

為了讓更多教育及社福界同工認識「故事介入治療法」,我們在5月舉行了網上分享會,與 110多位小學教師、社工及兒童工作者分享故事介入治療法的成效、以繪本推行家長教育的 經驗及推介欺凌主題繪本。超過八成參加者同意分享會讓他們知道如何透過繪本預防或減 少兒童的欺凌行為及認識更多欺凌主題的繪本,更有超過九成參加者同意分享會讓他們認 識到如何以繪本協助家長改善教養方式。

With the support from the Community Chest, the project has been further expanded. Apart from centre and school-based social groups, we organized talks and educational workshops in primary schools. This year, 11 primary schools joined the project, and beneficiaries reached 8,979. Through reading storybooks, scenario discussions and authentic stories, students were able to understand the importance of respect for differences and dealing with bullying. Parent workshops provided storybook sharing and experiential activities, which inspired parents the way of parenting and encouraged parents to get along with kids empathetically. To motivate parents and children, A reading handbook was also published to support parents in storybook reading with activity suggestions.

To promote the intervention, we held an online sharing in May inviting more than 110 primary school teachers, social workers and children-related workers, sharing the effectiveness of the therapy and our experience on implementation practically. More than 80% of the participants agreed that the sharing was able to let them know how to prevent bullying through storytelling. More than 90% of them understood that storytelling can improve parenting.

We also organized a social environmental simulation game for kids to have a taste on planning and spending their money as well as pricing out products, hence building a positive value of money and reducing waste.

We invited senior students from primary school to join our market as vendors and encouraged them to think about how their dream stall would look like. Students with inspiring ideas were chosen to participate the financial management workshop and was guided by professional tutors on stall operation and economic concepts. Lastly, participants were grouped to prepare for running their own stall in September 2022. They brainstormed ideas, learnt to manage cost and merchandise for their own stall.

Apart from the activities mentioned, we created a story and animated it to promote the "3S of money.

竹園中心與包威信中心於2021年10 月至2022年4月以線上形式與香港 專業教育學院合辦簡義學實習學 劃,學院的幼兒教育高級文 灣院的幼兒教育高級文 灣門中心實習。期間,本 員分享講繪本故事技巧、本何 設事 為本活動內容、創作故事 語夢工場等,讓一班準老師之 故事為本的服務理念及本會中的故 事活動共有53位實習同學參與的故 事行了24節活動,接近300人次的兒 童參與。

實習計劃分兩個階段,實習同學於第一階段需與小學生進行配對,為黃大仙區內的6至12歲的兒童進行講故事及功課輔導實習,觀察及了講故事及功課輔導實習,觀察及了第四階段的「繪本延伸活動」,實別各自創作一個繪本故事實別的故事製作成電子繪本及實體故事製作成電子繪本及實體故事學別的故事書,於網上與兒童參加者進行故事學習活動。小朋友都很享受這次活動。

Chuk Yuen Centre, Diana Boyd Wilson's Centre and the IVE (Shatin) organized an online "Easy Learning Internship Program" collaboratively from October 2021 to April 2022. Participants included students from the Higher Diploma in Child Care and Education, IVE (Shatin). To let these future teachers understand more about the benefits of storytelling as a teaching strategy and the diversified services of our centre, our storytellers shared various storytelling skills, tips to plan storytelling activities and some good ways to create stories with them. They also visited the Storyland. 53 students participated in this 24-session internship program and served around 300 beneficiaries.

The internship program was divided into two parts. In the first part, participants were required to match with 6 to 12 year-old primary school students in Wong Tai Sin district, and to provide storytelling activities as well as tutorial classes. They had to observe and understand the needs of different age groups of children. In the second part – "storybook extension activities", grouped participants had to collaborate with students of the Department of Communication Design and create digital and printed storybooks. They then carried out online storytelling activities with the children.

承蒙香港各界扶貧促進會及香港各界扶弱基金 會贊助,安徒生會得以於2021年10月開展了 「好義教-繪本學習語文計劃」,支援因疫情 關係,經濟及學習受影響的基層家庭小朋友。

安徒生會於2021年11月在童話夢工場舉行了「好義教」計劃啟動禮暨「小雲朵」繪本活動,正式開始「好義教-繪本學習語文計劃」服務。計劃為96位小朋友,提供5節中文及英文共10節的繪本學語文課程。家長在小朋友的學習上都扮演著重要的角色,因此計劃亦會邀請家長,與小朋友一同參與親子家長工作坊,例如慈善親子靜觀工作坊,於疫情期間抒緩壓力,放鬆心情,並增加親子溝通機會。

計劃又會招募義工提供義工訓練,為小朋友提供繪本故事活動。期間因疫情關係,需於2022年1月至4月暫停實體服務,改為網上活動模式,繼續服務小朋友。



An opening ceremony at Storyland in November 2021 marked the beginning of the program. 96 children were served in 5 sessions of Chinese and 5 sessions of English language lessons. Parents play an important role in children's learning. Therefore, parents were also invited to join workshops such as fundraising parent-child mindfulness workshops with their kids to relieve stress from the lockdown days and promote the parent-child relationship.



We also provided training for volunteers and storytelling services for kids. Despite the suspension of face-to-face lessons due to the epidemic, online service was available to serve children.

Chuk Yuen Centre and the H.K.S.K.H. Chuk Yuen Canon Martin District Elderly Community Centre had organized a joint program, "Love, Family, Friends" Online Network Program. 13 child and 18 senior volunteers participated in these 7-session program and served 305 senior beneficiaries in the district. This project sponsored by the Social Welfare Department - "Opportunities for the Elderly Project" 2021-2022, has won the 2021/22 1-Year Project - Wong Tai Sin and Sai Kung District Best Activity Award and the gold award in the Best '1-Year Project' Award of Hong Kong.

This project aimed to encourage senior and teenager volunteers who are familiar with new technologies to promote smart devices among elderly people. To make it easy to get started with, we first introduced interesting robots and photo retouch activities to the senior participants, at the same time taught them how to use digital devices. We hope senior participants will be interested in and become more proactive in learning new technologies and foster the understanding between teenagers and seniors as well as cross-generational Integration.

We were glad to see how well children have grown throughout the project. In the beginning, children volunteers were shy to talk to the seniors, but after some time, they could patiently explain how to control the robots to the seniors and taught seniors how to use smartphone apps. A volunteer Wong said, "My past impression towards seniors was slowlearner and physically disabled. However, I found that seniors could also learn positively and fast when they persevered to finish the robot competitions. They didn't give up when they had to overcome new challenges. Their perseverance and learning attitude are really something that we need to learn." Another volunteer also said that this was the first time he enters an elderly centre and get to know the elderly service.


